A NEW RECORD FOR THE 'FLORA OF TURKEY'

Just over a year after the appearance of Vol. 7 of the Flora of Turkey and the East Aegeon Islands, Professor Assuman Baytop of the Islanbul Üniversitesie Eczacikie Fakülteis Herbaryumu brought a spurge specimen to Kew which she had collected in June 1972 from the vicinity of Edirine. This clearly belonged to Group H in the key to Euphophia (Sect. Eudae) but, being pubescent, was obviously not extered for therein. Her collection has in fact proved to be referable to the European E-astlefolia Host, which thus collection and Moutered with the Baytopia County of the Section Control of the Sect
